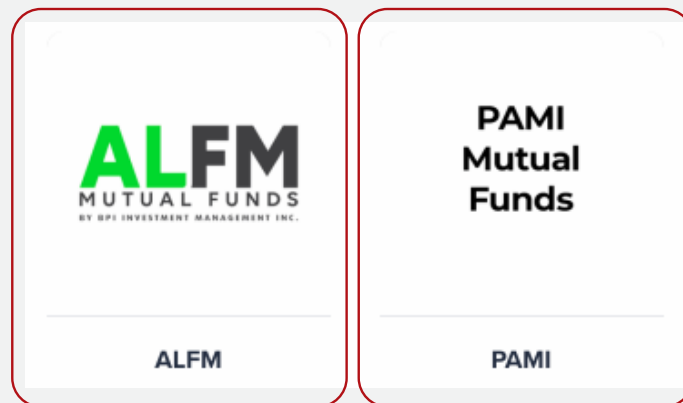


More payment options with your BPI online account.

Step 1: Visit <https://bpiquickpay.com>

Step 2: Scroll down and look for “ALFM” or “PAMI”



Step 3: Fill-out the required information

Supply your “**Email Address**”

Choose your “**Mutual Fund**”

Press “**Validate Transaction**” when done

Once validated, click “**Transaction is valid, click to start payment**”.




